We can't wait to unveil it before we depart for Adelaide in just a few weeks time!

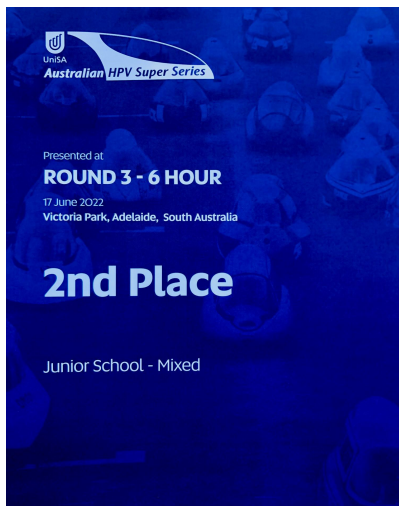
Thank you to our P&F, who had kindly offered to co-fund a new bike, topping up any contribution required should the Acciona grant application prove successful or unsuccessful either way.

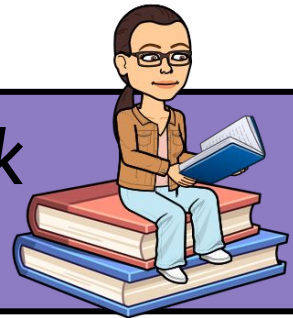

The diagonal lines are our roll through zone for a quick drop off or pick up. Please stay in your car and exit our car park once your kids are in if you use this zone.
If you'd like to hop out and chat/stay for a play after school – do not park on these diagonal lines. Pedestrians – please keep this area clear at end of day for cars rolling in and out seeking express pick ups.



Cars – 5km/h speed limit in our carparks.

Pedestrians – stay visible to drivers and follow the yellow line in front of cars – we do not want children or adults walking behind parked cars.



Drivers – please be aware of pedestrians walking from centre carparks using this walkway to the school gate.
